### ESD-U field experience parameters are specifically designed to be flexible to meet the needs of districts.

**PLACEMENT** can be in classrooms that are similar to where districts anticipate needing the candidate in the future (ideally for future teaching positions). Candidates should be working with at least one (1) student from the endorsement areas.

- SPED: Candidates should work in special education classrooms (K-12) with students on IEPs/504 plans.
- **ELEM:** Candidates should work in general education classrooms (K-12). It is recommended to get some experience (general or student teaching) in different content areas. This experience can be the candidate doing an observation, assisting with instruction for the class, and/or instructing the class. (*No current time requirement.*)
- **ELL & ELEM:** Candidates should work in general education classrooms (K-12) and/or multilingual support environments AND work with at least one (1) student who is identified as ELL.
- **SPED & ELEM:** Candidates should work in special education classrooms (K-12) AND also work with at least one (1) student who is considered general education (i.e., does not have an IEP/504 plan).

**GRADE LEVEL** for placement can be based on district need and/or candidate preference. For **ELEM** candidates it is recommended to get some experience (general or student teaching) in different grade level bands (K-2, 3-5, 6-8). This experience can include observations, assisting with instruction, and/or leading instruction. (*No current time requirement.*)

**STUDENT TEACHING** involves the candidate <u>creating</u> lessons and <u>leading</u> instruction for a <u>consistent group</u> of students over a <u>consecutive period of time</u>. Student teaching hours can be full, consecutive days OR a different format if that will better serve the school/students (ex: half days, Mon/Wed/Fri, specific periods, etc.).

**GENERAL FIELD EXPERIENCE** for ESD-U includes three main categories: 1) Working with students, 2) Case management activities and 3) Leading adults. Examples of general field experience include (but are not limited to) working as a paraeducator, observing classrooms, attending PLC meetings, reviewing assessment data, collaborating with educators/specialists, attending parent meetings, leading paraeducators, etc. The following does not count towards general field experience: Professional development, grading, prep time, playground duty, coaching.

**MENTORS** should be assigned to candidates prior to the beginning of their field experience and should be selected based on current <u>Beginning Educator Support Team (BEST) mentor standards</u>. Names and email addresses for mentors should be sent to program staff for reporting purposes and payment.

**ESD-U FIELD EXPERIENCE CHECKLIST** outlines specific activities for candidates to complete. This checklist can be used by candidates, mentors, and district staff to ensure candidates are receiving a thorough and varied field experience.

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
